We were elected to represent 300 service employees at the Sisters of Charity St. Joseph's Campus in April 2009 after a very anti-union campaign by CHS. We have been bargaining their first contract since July 2009. CHS continues to stall and drag out this bargaining. Why? Because they are afraid that if we are successful in negotiating a strong contract with this group, you will want to be organized next. CHS is afraid of what a unified workforce across the system would mean.
